What's It Really Like (WIRL) has a goal of directing students towards accredited training pathways after they have had the industry visits, and even after having undertaken a Structured Workplace Learning placement facilitated by NE Tracks or NELLEN.

The Certificate II / III courses can be delivered as a standalone VET course or conducted as part of a School-based Apprenticeship/ Traineeship, or in tandem with VCE study. The following resources are available to further information about these choices. The Victorian Curriculum and Assessment Authority (VCAA) website has the most current details about VET delivery to Secondary Students (VDSS). This website will be particularly useful as the Senior Secondary Pathways Reform is implemented and the VCE Vocational Major and the Victorian Pathways Certificates commence. The certificates that form part of the six (core) offerings and six (elective) pathways are marked below. Those certificates also identified as FT are currently listed by the Victorian Government as priority courses with tuition fees fully covered for eligible students to attend government-subsidised training.
